



We have lots in store over the coming weeks including our extended P.1 Induction, P7 transition events, 'Sharing the Learning' events for Parent/Carers, Educational Excursions ...to name but a few. Already we can see that we are going to have a very full Burnside Primary next session. As the process of P1 placing request reviews is underway and will continue throughout the term, as always we will not be in a position to confirm next year's classes until mid June at the earliest.

You may be aware that all P1, 4 and 7 pupils will undertake Scottish National Standardised Assessments (SNSA) on an annual basis from this year. These assessments will take place soon in school. The assessments form only one part of the breadth of assessment un-

dertaken by the class teacher and although scores are not produced, the assessments will provide useful information for teachers on pupil strengths and next steps for development. More information can be found by visiting https://
