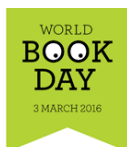
Monday 29 February ~ Fairtrade Treasure Hunt begins (voluntary and 50p to take part).

Tuesday 1 March ~ pupils are invited to bring a Fairtrade snack to school for a sticker.

Wednesday 9 March ~ Fairtrade tasting (tbc).

Thursday 10 March ~ Big Fairtrade Breakfast for families of Room 8 and committee members as well as neighbours.

Friday 11 March ~ Fairtrade Committee have organised assemblies for all pupils.



We would like to invite pupils to celebrate **World Book Day on Thursday 3 March**, by dressing up as their favourite book character. Pupils can vote for their class winner who will receive a small prize. There will also be an extra focus on literacy during the week and we will send home World Book Day tokens.

Thursday 3 March is also International School Meals day (menus have been issued).
